


Advanced Search Capabilities

- ► Provide details for companies that have listed on ASX since 2007 including listing date, amount raised, and underwriter.
- Which companies currently have operations in China?
- Rank the top 100 companies on ASX by market capitalisation and provide their GICS industry group, balance date, and revenue.
- ► Provide details of all successful takeover offers made in 2009.
- Compile a list of all ASX companies ranked by market capitalisation as at 30 June 2009.



Search the text of PDF-based ASX announcements with custom criteria selections.

Example Search Queries

- ► Search all takeover announcements since 2009 for the term "break fee."
- Which of the big four Australian banks have Basel 11 accreditation from APRA?
- ► Find references to their Carbon Pollution Reduction Scheme for companies within GICS Metals & Mining Industry.
- ► Locate independent expert reports lodged in the last six months.
